Frequently Asked Questions:

Question: Am I required to attend the three lectures?

Answer: Yes, students are required to attend all of the lectures.

Question: How do I register to attend the above events?

Answer: Please register at the following link: <https://mapatter.wufoo.com/forms/m1yhyjt31yplc2v/>.

Question: How late can I wait to register?

Answer: The deadline to register is Monday, September 20, although it would be greatly appreciated if you would sign up as soon as possible.

Question: How does my spouse/companion register?

Answer: Your spouse/companion needs to register separately at the same link noted above.

Question: Is childcare provided during the lectures and alumni events?

Answer: No, childcare is not provided. A list of available sitters can be provided upon request.

Question: Should I wear my academic gown to the lectures?

Answer: Yes.

Question: Can I attend the alumni events noted on the schedule?

Answer: Yes, you can attend along with your spouse/companion (or other guest). Please register each person online using the link that Mary Ann will email you. Sign up by September 20. Also note medical dietary and physical restrictions on the form.

Question: Do I have to pay for any Alumni Lectures & Homecoming events?

Answer: No, you do not have to pay for anything.

Question: How will I gain entry into the alumni meals?

Answer: Those who register for the alumni meals will be provided a name tag and must wear their nametag to the alumni meals as a method of entry.

Question: Where do I get my nametag?

Answer: Students and their guest's name tags will be available for pick up in the Student Common Room on Monday morning, Sept. 27. If name tags are not picked up by Tuesday morning, Sept. 28, then the name tags can be picked up at the registration table in Hamilton Hall Foyer on Tuesday afternoon or in Guerry Lobby on Wednesday morning, Sept. 29.

Question: What is the attire for the Alumni reception and dinner on Wednesday evening?

Answer: "Sunday best"/clericals or tuxedo/evening dress (optional).

Question: I have heard that in recent years, a photo was taken of anyone who wanted to have a picture made. Will this happen this year?

Answer: Yes, you are welcome to have your picture made as you enter the reception in the tent next to Cravens Hall between 6 and 6:45 p.m. You will be able to download your picture from Flickr, free of charge. A link to Flickr is at the bottom of the School's website.

Question: For the events which are being held on the central campus, where can I park?

Answer: You can park anywhere along University Avenue between where the signs are posted. The "Event Parking" signs will be up along University Avenue for Alumni Lectures & Homecoming Events on Tuesday evening, Sept. 28 and Wednesday, Sept. 29. For the daytime events, you can park in the Tennessee Williams parking lot and catch a shuttle to central campus. The Thursday, Sept. 30 events will occur at the School of Theology campus.
