### Proof of Medical Insurance

All students must have health insurance, and must provide a copy of his or her health insurance card to Sandra Brock at [sbbrock@sewanee.edu](mailto:sbbrock@sewanee.edu) during orientation and at the beginning of each new semester.

The school of theology only offers the plans available to seminarians through Church Medical Trust. If your insurance is through other channels, be aware that at a minimum, your policy must have coverage for (1) Physician Services, and (2) Hospital Services. Your insurance must cover required services in the state of Tennessee. Regardless of the source of your health insurance, you will be responsible for medical expenses that are not covered by your plan.

Students will not be allowed to attend classes without proof of insurance. Failure to maintain health insurance coverage may result in a reduction or forfeiture of financial aid eligibility or in academic suspension.
