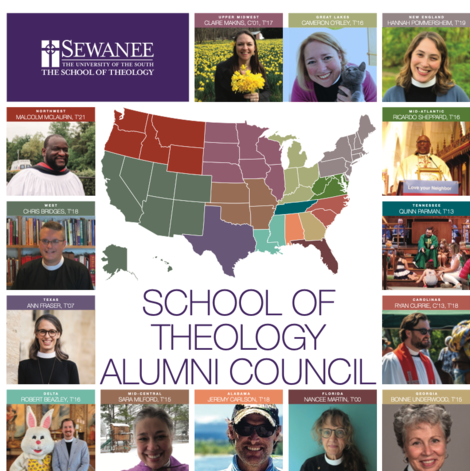

When The Rev. Simion Kinono, T'21, came to Sewanee from Burundi to pursue his formation, he developed a second calling: protector and champion of Burundi's environment.
